She has prepared budgets, conducted superintendent and board training, and consulted in the area of school finance. A licensed CPA since 1995, she has worked as a field examiner with the Indiana State Board of Accounts and in private practice consulting with nonprofits and individuals. She has a doctorate in educational leadership and curriculum from Indiana University and a BS in finance from the Kelley School of Business. Dr. Moore's expertise is in financial management for schools, understanding and working in declining enrollment, and updating curriculum and student programs for the demands of the 21st century.
